## MAKERS WIN JUBILEE PRIZES



On Saturday 4th June, Liskeard Town Council mounted an art exhibition at the Public Hall to mark the jubilee weekend. The show attracted about 70 visitors.

The show featured the finalists in the town's jubilee art competition, including work from local primary and secondary schools.

First prize in the adult section of the competition went to local artist <u>Lee Rendle</u> for his dramatic impressionist oil painting of a fishing boat in a storm at night.

'I've been overwhelmed by people's positive comments about my work,' said Lee. 'To win against such strong competition was hugely encouraging.'

A selection of Lee's paintings will be exhibited later this month at the DAK Art gallery in Liskeard's Old Brewery indoor market.

The show also featured an exhibition of the work of other members of the Market Makers group, including paintings by <u>Karen Burden</u> and <u>Ann Kinahan</u>, henna art by <u>Bibi Wilson</u>, textile art by <u>Laura Welsh</u>, dolls by <u>Kellyann Horsburgh</u>, prints by Dawn Curtis, jewellery by Meg Bateson, glass work from <u>DAK Art</u>, and upholstery from <u>Vardo Upholstery</u>. There was also a display of crafting kits produced by <u>Pot Stars Studio</u>, who kindly donated prizes in the junior category.

Our good friend, the brilliant ceramic artist Ray Toms was also at his wheel demonstrating how to throw pots and encouraging enthusiastic visitors to have a go.
