## **NEW ENTREPRENEURS**



We have launched a new series of free classes to help local artists and craftspeople turn their hobbies into businesses, exploring everything from financial sustainability and business planning through to marketing strategies and social value

Our group of aspiring creative entrepreneurs meets for half a day each week to learn how to establish, register and grow a viable business enterprise.

The group includes Kirsty, who is in the process of developing a business called MonChic Mosaics. 'It's opening my eyes to the realities of starting a business, and the challenges and the opportunities,' says Kirsty. 'It's very different from when your mum says "That's beautiful – you could sell that!" It's showing me what will work, and what won't.'

Lee Rendle is self-taught artist specializing in landscape paintings. 'I've been painting for a long time, and I'm really excited about discovering how to develop routes to market and getting my work out there,' says Lee. Laura Welsh is a mixed media artist working in textiles and ceramics. 'As an artist you perhaps don't think too much about the business side,' says Laura. 'This gives me the chance to develop my business model and helps me understand and refine the direction I want my work to take. I'm learning to be able to pursue a career where my passion is my world, and I'm learning how to turn my passions into profits.'

'That would be ideal,' adds Lee.
